Mexican American and Latina/o Studies

Major

Twenty-seven semester credit hours in Mexican American and Latina/o Studies, including 18 hours upper-division and 18 hours in residence. The following courses are required:

- a. Mexican American Studies 301, Introduction to Mexican American and Latina/o Studies
- b. Six semester credit hours of lower-division Mexican American and Latina/o Studies
- c. Twelve semester credit hours of upper-division Mexican American and Latina/o Studies
- d. Mexican American Studies 378, Capstone Seminar
- e. Completion of one of the following is required.
 - i. Mexican American Studies 375, Internship
 - ii. Study Abroad (approved)

Students majoring in Mexican American and Latina/o Studies must achieve, at a minimum, an intermediate level of proficiency in Spanish, Portuguese, or a relevant Indigenous language.
