Admission Requirements

The admissions timeline and criteria for the Master of Science in Business Analytics Option III program ([on campus](#) and [online](#)) is separate from other degrees in the department. The MSBA program is offered in two formats: full-time (FT) format and working-professional (WP) format. The FT program begins in the second term of the summer semester and concludes 10 months later, the following spring semester; the WP program begins in the first term of the summer semester and

concludes 22 months later in the spring semester. Applicants admitted to the MS in Business Analytics Option III program will be required to submit a [nonrefundable enrollment deposit](#) to secure enrollment in the program.

The MS Bridge Program offers undergraduate students at The University of Texas at Austin an opportunity to prepare for future graduate study by providing access to courses and program resources that normally require graduate standing. University of Texas at Austin undergraduate students may apply for admission through the graduate academic unit sponsoring the bridge program.
