ACF 110C, 210C, 310C, 410C Conference Course 1-4 Hours
Supervised study of selected subjects by individual arrangement with department and instructor.

ACF 112M Actuarial Laboratory on Probability and Statistics 1 Hour
Problems and supplementary instruction in probability and statistics, especially as required for the Society of Actuaries and Casualty Actuarial Society Exam 110.

ACF 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in Actuarial Foundations 1-9 Hours
This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of Mathematics. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

ACF 129D Introductory Actuarial Financial Mathematics 1 Hour
Introductory analysis of financial derivatives. Covers the financial derivatives portion of the syllabus for the professional actuarial exam on financial mathematics.
