

Chinese (CHI)

CHI 604 Accelerated First-Year Chinese 6 Hours
Learn Modern Standard Chinese (Mandarin).

CHI 506, 606 First-Year Chinese I 5-6 Hours
Modern Standard Chinese (Mandarin). Intended for students who do not understand or speak Mandarin Chinese.

CHI 507, 607 First-Year Chinese II 5-6 Hours
Continuation of Chinese 506, 606. Intended for non-native speakers of Chinese.

CHI 612 Accelerated Second-Year Chinese 6 Hours
Continuation of Chinese 604.

CHI 312K, 412K Second-Year Chinese I 3-4 Hours
Modern Standard Chinese (Mandarin). Intended for non-native speakers of Chinese.

CHI 312L, 412L Second-Year Chinese II 3-4 Hours
Intended for non-native speakers of Chinese. Continuation of Chinese 312K, 412K.

CHI 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in Chinese 1-9 Hours
This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of Asian Studies. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

CHI 320K Readings in Modern Chinese I 3 Hours
Readings in expository prose: selections from journals, newspapers, and other sources.

CHI 320L Readings in Modern Chinese II 3 Hours
Readings in modern fiction, poetry, and drama.

CHI 322 Introduction to Classical Chinese 3 Hours
Beginning study of wen yen, the particles, and syntax of the Chinese classics.

CHI 325K Advanced Conversation I 3 Hours
Drill in conversation on general topics.

CHI 325L Advanced Conversation II 3 Hours
Practice in speaking Modern Standard Chinese.

CHI 326 Business Chinese 3 Hours
Advanced Chinese conversation, with emphasis on business vocabulary.

CHI 129S, 229S, 329S, 429S, 529S, 629S, 729S, 829S, 929S Topics in Chinese 1-9 Hours
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CHI 330 Topics in Advanced Chinese 3 Hours
Fourth-year Chinese readings on special topics.

CHI 130D Chinese across Disciplines 1 Hour
Reading and discussion of Chinese language materials related to the subject matter of another designated course in Asian studies. Meetings with the instructor will be devoted to the discussion of linguistic problems, literary features, and crucial passages.

CHI 340 Topics in Chinese Literature 3 Hours
Study of Chinese literary texts in the original.

CHI 340.1 Contemporary Chinese Literature 3 Hours
Selected literary works from contemporary China (post 1949), in their original language. Focuses on translation and linguistic analysis, as well as discussion of the texts as works of literature.

CHI 340.2 Prose Writings by Lu Xun 3 Hours

CHI 340.3 Modern Chinese Literature 3 Hours
Selected literary works from modern China (pre 1949), focusing on translation, linguistic analysis, and discussion of these works as cultural and literary products within their socio-historical contexts.

CHI 340.4 Chinese Fiction from Taiwan 3 Hours
Readings of works of fiction produced in contemporary Taiwan (1949 to present day) in Chinese. Readings include mainstream literature, stories written by writers of the Modernist and Nativist schools, and urban fiction since the late twentieth century.

CHI 341 Classical Chinese Poetry 3 Hours
Study of Chinese poetry in the original.

CHI 360 Conference Course in Chinese Language and Literature 3 Hours
Supervised individual study of selected problems in Chinese language or literature.

CHI 381 Conference Course in Chinese Language and Culture 3 Hours
Supervised individual study in Chinese language or culture.

CHI 384 Topics in Chinese Language and Culture 3 Hours
Study of various aspects and periods of Chinese language or culture.

CHI 384.1 Chinese Film and Literature 3 Hours
Chinese literature and film from the early twentieth century to the present within the sociohistorical context of modern China.

CHI 384.7 Readings in Chinese Journals 3 Hours
