

Human Ecology (H E)

H E 101P Professional Development I 1 Hour

Explore common career paths, identify professional and personal goals, and develop entry-level career portfolios.

H E 102P Ethics Across Life 1 Hour

Examine applied ethics in the workplace and in adult life with a focus on working in teams and organizations effectively.

H E 103P Professional Development II 1 Hour

Explore a practical approach to professional self-presentation, leadership and decision-making, and career development.

H E 115H Freshman Honors Seminar 1 Hour

Research presentations by students, faculty, and invited scientists on current issues in human ecology, human development and family sciences, and nutrition.

H E 225H Sophomore Honors Seminar 2 Hours

Students plan, conduct, write, and present research on a current topic in human ecology.

H E 355 Topics in Problems Course 3 Hours

Intensive study of selected problems of a transdisciplinary nature.

H E 355.1 Research in Family Economics 3 Hours

H E 178H Honors Tutorial Course 1 Hour

Engage in supervised individual research on a special area in human development and family sciences; oral presentation and preparation of a scholarly paper covering the research.

H E 392 Topics in Research Problems 3 Hours

Problems may be chosen from the areas of family and consumer economics or textiles and apparel.
