

Italian (ITL)

ITL 601C Beginning Italian 6 Hours

An intensive beginning course with an emphasis on basic skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

ITL 604 Accelerated First-Year Italian 6 Hours

Designed for students of high motivation. A six-hour course comparable to Italian 506 and 507.

ITL 305 Introduction to Italian Language and Culture 3 Hours

An introductory course in Italian language and culture taught in Castiglion-Fiorentino, Italy.

ITL 611C Intermediate Italian 6 Hours

An intensive intermediate course with an emphasis on basic skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Does not meet the prerequisite requirements for Italian 328, 326K, or 326L.

ITL 612 Accelerated Second-Year Italian 6 Hours

Comparable to Italian 312K and 312L combined. Intensive work in writing, reading, and speaking at the second-year level.

ITL 317C Enhancing Italian Skills 3 Hours

Listening, speaking, reading, and writing course designed to provide students who have credit for Italian 611C with additional preparation for upper-division Italian courses.

ITL 118K Practice in Spoken Italian I 1 Hour

Designed to be taken concurrently with Italian 312K.

ITL 118L Practice in Spoken Italian II 1 Hour

Designed to be taken concurrently with Italian 312L.

ITL 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in Italian 1-9 Hours

This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of French and Italian. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

ITL 320 Advanced Italian 3 Hours

Designed to develop the listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills needed for the analysis of literary and cultural readings in Italian.

ITL 321 Introduction to Italian Literature 3 Hours

Reading and analysis of literature, literary criticism, textual analysis.

ITL 322L Tradition and Change in Contemporary Italy 3 Hours

An analysis of Italy's trends and of conflicting values in its political, economic, and social development.

ITL 325C Italian Through Cinema 3 Hours

Designed to enrich knowledge of Italian language and culture through screening and discussion of Italian films.

ITL 326C Italian through Creative Writing 3 Hours

Develop knowledge of Italian lexicon and its grammar through creative writing practice.

ITL 327C Italian through Cuisine 3 Hours

Refine reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills in Italian through the context of gastronomy.

ITL 328 Composition and Conversation 3 Hours

Focuses on idioms, grammar, syntax, and style.

ITL 329 Advanced Composition and Conversation 3 Hours

Advanced work in writing and speech, based on current events and contemporary readings.

ITL 129S, 229S, 329S, 429S, 529S, 629S, 729S, 829S, 929S Topics in Italian 1-9 Hours

This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of French and Italian. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

ITL 330 Topics in Italian Studies 3 Hours

Analysis of Italian culture. Texts include literature, film, popular culture, and other forms.

ITL 330C The Language of Italian Crime Fiction 3 Hours

Analyze Italian language and culture as reflected in the crime fiction genre studies through literature, film, popular culture, and other forms.

ITL 130D Italian across Disciplines 1 Hour

Students read and discuss Italian language materials related to the subject matter of another designated course.

ITL 330L Introduction to Italian Linguistics 3 Hours

Examine fundamental aspects of the Italian language including its structure as well as geographical, socio-cultural and communicative variation.

ITL 332 Italian Translation Workshop 3 Hours

Focuses on the practical aspects of translation as a means to expand students' resources by practicing and improving grammar, style and lexicon.

ITL 346 Italian Politics 3 Hours

Explore the Italian language, culture, and society through the examination of Italy's political system and the organization of the Italian government.

ITL 347 Italian Popular Cinema 3 Hours

Analysis of Italian genre films (melodrama, comedy, horror, western, action), in their cultural and historical contexts.

ITL 348 Italian Drama Workshop 3 Hours

Intensive analysis of one or several plays or short literary texts, with emphasis on diction, delivery of lines, and acting and staging.

ITL 349P Italian Internship 3 Hours

ITL 358Q Supervised Research 3 Hours

ITL 365 Conference Course in Italian Language and Literature 3 Hours
Course content varies according to needs of students; designed to fill in gaps and give students a good overall picture of the development of Italian literature.

ITL 375C The Antihero in the Twentieth-Century Italian Novel 3 Hours

Explore the crisis of certainties at the turn of the last century and the end of the role of the hero, through the examination of major Italian novels.

ITL 375F Writing Fascism: Writing the Resistance 3 Hours

Examine major novels dealing with the Italian narrative on World War II and the resistance.

ITL 375N Neorealism and its Legacy 3 Hours

Analyze the legacy of neorealism in Italian literature and cinema from approximately the late 1940s to the early 1950s.

ITL 375S Sicily in Literature and Film 3 Hours

Examine Sicilian culture through novels and films.

ITL 379H Honors Tutorial Course 3 Hours

Supervised individual research on a literary, linguistic, or cultural topic, and writing and defense of a thesis under the direction of a committee of two faculty members.

ITL 380C Italian for Graduate Students in Other Departments 3 Hours
Intensive reading course, emphasizing basic grammar and vocabulary with translation practice.

ITL 380L History of the Italian Language 3 Hours
Survey of the development of Italian from spoken Latin to the present day.

ITL 180P Introduction to Studies in Literature and Culture 1 Hour
Proseminar in methods of study and research in Italian Studies.

ITL 380W Doctoral Writing Workshop 3 Hours
Acquire the crucial skills for writing a cogent prospectus, dissertation, or article, and complete the prospectus, dissertation chapter, or article.

ITL 381 Topics in Readings in Italian Literature 3 Hours
Intensive study of a period or a major writer.

ITL 382 Topics in Italian Studies 3 Hours
Study of various aspects and periods of Italian culture and society.

ITL 383K Studies in Italian Language 3 Hours
Synchronic approach to the modern Italian language: phonology, morphology, syntax, lexicology, stylistics.

ITL 385L Conference Course in Italian Language and Literature 3 Hours
For students needing specialized courses not normally or not often included in the regular course offerings.

ITL 385T Graduate Teaching Practicum 3 Hours
Engage in mentorship and pedagogical training by working one-on-one with a faculty member to develop and design an undergraduate, upper-division level course in an area of specialization.

ITL 390K Topics in Italian Literature through the Renaissance 3 Hours
Intensive study of a particular writer, school, or literary movement.

ITL 390L Topics in Italian Literature since the Renaissance 3 Hours
Intensive study of a particular writer, school, or literary movement.

ITL 395L Comprehensive Examination Preparation 3 Hours
Supervised preparation for the comprehensive examination for the doctoral degree.

ITL 396K Topics in Comparative Romance Linguistics 3 Hours
General survey of the development of spoken Latin in Italy, Spain, Portugal, and France; main traits of phonology, morphology, and syntax in each modern derivative language.

ITL 396K.1 Introduction to Romance Linguistics 3 Hours

ITL 698 Thesis 6 Hours

ITL 398R Master's Report 3 Hours
Preparation of a report to fulfill the requirement for the master's degree under the report option.

ITL 398T Supervised Teaching in Italian 3 Hours
Practical exercises in second-language instruction and closely supervised classroom teaching, supported by theoretical studies of second-language learning.
