KOR 604 Accelerated First-Year Korean 6 Hours

KOR 506, 606 First-Year Korean I 5-6 Hours

Intended for non-native speakers of Korean.

KOR 507, 607 First-Year Korean II 5-6 Hours

Continuation of Korean 506, 606. Intended for non-native speakers of Korean.

KOR 612 Accelerated Second-Year Korean 6 Hours

Continuation of Korean 604.

KOR 312K, 412K Second-Year Korean I 3-4 Hours

Intended for non-native speakers of Korean.

KOR 312L, 412L Second-Year Korean II 3-4 Hours

Intended for non-native speakers of Korean.

KOR 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in Korean 1-9 Hours

This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of Asian Studies. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

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KOR 330 Topics in Advanced Korean 3 Hours

Fourth-year Korean readings on special topics.

KOR 330.1 Advanced Conversation in Korean 3 Hours

Emphasis on achieving an advanced level of proficiency in modern conversational Korean, with additional practice in advanced writing and listening skills.

KOR 330.2 Advanced Readings in Korean I 3 Hours

Selected modern Korean poems, short stories, and essays to develop reading and writing skills in advanced Korean. Includes discussion of cultural and historical issues.

KOR 330C Introduction to Modern Korean Literature 3 Hours

KOR 330F Korean Conversation through Media 3 Hours

Develop conversational skills in Korean language through the analysis of authentic Korean media resources such as newspapers, the Internet, TV news, and audio files. Focus on the comprehension, analysis, translation, and critique of media texts, as well as some formal speaking.

KOR 360 Conference Course in Korean Language and Literature 3 Hours

Supervised individual study of selected problems in Korean language or literature.

KOR 381 Conference Course in Korean Language and Culture 3 Hours

Supervised individual study in Korean language or culture.
