NOR 604 Accelerated First-Year Norwegian 6 Hours

NOR 612 Accelerated Second-Year Norwegian 6 Hours

NOR 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in Norwegian 1-9 Hours

This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser for the Department of Germanic Studies. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer work is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

NOR 327 Advanced Norwegian I 3 Hours

Norwegian language and culture with a focus on the skills of speaking, comprehension, reading, and writing Norwegian.

NOR 328 Advanced Norwegian II 3 Hours

Continuation of Norwegian 327. Further study of Norwegian reading, writing, speaking, and aural comprehension. Readings include contemporary journalism, fiction, and other texts that promote the understanding of a modern Scandinavian society.

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NOR 130D Norwegian across Disciplines 1 Hour

Read and discuss Norwegian language materials related to the subject matter of another designated course.

NOR 379 Conference Course in Norwegian Language or Literature 3 Hours

Supervised individual study of selected problems in Norwegian language or literature.
