S S 302D Honors Social Science: Psychology 3 Hours

An introduction to the study of the individual, society, or culture using the methods of the social science discipline of Psychology.

S S 302E Honors Social Science: Anthropology 3 Hours

An introduction to the study of the individual, society, or culture using the methods of the social science discipline of Anthropology.

An introduction to the study of the individual, society, or culture using the methods of the social science discipline of Economics.
