SAL 506 Topics in First Year South Asian Languages I 5 Hours
Emphasis on four-skills proficiency: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

SAL 507 Topics in First Year South Asian Languages II 5 Hours
Emphasis on four-skills proficiency: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

SAL 312K Topics in Second Year South Asian Languages I 3 Hours
Listening, speaking, reading, and writing at the second-year level.

SAL 312L Topics in Second-Year South Asian Languages II 3 Hours
Listening, speaking, reading, and writing at the advanced, second-year level.

SAL 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in South Asian Languages 1-9 Hours
This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of Asian Studies. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.
