TUR 601C Intensive Turkish I 6 Hours

First semester of intensive Turkish language instruction.

TUR 506 First-Year Turkish I 5 Hours

Modern Standard Turkish.

TUR 507 First-Year Turkish II 5 Hours

Modern Standard Turkish. Continuation of Turkish 506.

TUR 611C Intensive Turkish II 6 Hours

Second semester of intensive Turkish language instruction.

TUR 412K Second-Year Turkish I 4 Hours

Conversational Turkish and readings in contemporary Turkish literature and newspapers. Review of the grammar covered in Turkish 506 and 507, and introduction of more complex grammatical patterns.

TUR 412L Second-Year Turkish II 4 Hours

Continuation of Turkish 412K.

TUR 119S, 219S, 319S, 419S, 519S, 619S, 719S, 819S, 919S Topics in Turkish 1-9 Hours

This course is used to record credit the student earns while enrolled at another institution in a program administered by the University's Study Abroad Office. Credit is recorded as assigned by the study abroad adviser in the Department of Middle Eastern Studies. University credit is awarded for work in an exchange program; it may be counted as coursework taken in residence. Transfer credit is awarded for work in an affiliated studies program.

TUR 320K Intermediate Turkish I 3 Hours

Intermediate to high-level Turkish in four basic language skills: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Turkish culture.

TUR 320L Intermediate Turkish II 3 Hours

Continuation of Turkish 320K.

TUR 325K Advanced Turkish I 3 Hours

TUR 325L Advanced Turkish II 3 Hours

Advanced Turkish language instruction.

TUR 329 Topics in Turkish Language, Literature, and Culture 3 Hours

Conducted in Turkish.

TUR 329C Turkish Cinema 3 Hours

TUR 329D Turkish Society and Culture 3 Hours

Explore aspects of contemporary Turkish society and culture while building intercultural communicative competence in modern Turkish through listening, speaking, reading, and writing activities in and outside of class. Focus on daily life and material culture, and guides students to develop efficient reading, listening, and viewing strategies.

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TUR 130D Turkish across Disciplines 1 Hour

Students read and discuss Turkish language materials related to the subject matter of another designated course.

TUR 369 Conference Course in Turkish Language and Literature 3 Hours

Supervised individual study of selected problems in Turkish language or literature.

TUR 380 Topics in Turkish Language and Literature 3 Hours

Study of various aspects or eras of Turkish language and literature.

TUR 381H Intensive Graduate Language Instruction I 3 Hours

Intensive cultural and literacy-focused training in Turkish at the beginning level in preparation for research in the Turkic-speaking world or with Turkish sources. Incoming students are placed in the appropriate level by means of a departmental placement test.

TUR 381J Intensive Graduate Language Instruction II 3 Hours

Intensive cultural and literacy-focused training in Turkish at the low-intermediate level in preparation for research in the Turkic-speaking world or with Turkish sources. Incoming students are placed in the appropriate level by means of a departmental placement test.

TUR 381K Intermediate Graduate Language Instruction I 3 Hours

Intensive cultural and literacy-focused training in Turkish at the intermediate level in preparation for research in the Turkic-speaking world or with Turkish sources. Includes an independent project component. Incoming students are placed in the appropriate level by means of a departmental placement test.

TUR 381L Intermediate Graduate Language Instruction II 3 Hours

Intensive cultural and literacy-focused training in Turkish at the high-intermediate level in preparation for research in the Turkic-speaking world or with Turkish sources. Includes an independent project component. Incoming students are placed in the appropriate level by means of a placement test.

TUR 381M Advanced Language Instruction I 3 Hours

Intensive cultural and literacy-focused training in Turkish at the advanced level in preparation for research in the Turkic-speaking world or with Turkish sources. Incoming students are placed in the appropriate level by means of a departmental placement test.

TUR 381N Advanced Language Instruction II 3 Hours

Intensive cultural and literacy-focused training in Turkish at the advanced level in preparation for research in the Turkic-speaking world or with Turkish sources. Incoming students are placed in the appropriate level by means of a departmental placement test.

TUR 382 Topics in Turkish Culture 3 Hours

TUR 389 Conference Course in Turkish Studies 3 Hours

Supervised individual study of selected problems in Turkish studies.

TUR 390K Advanced Turkish I 3 Hours

Intermediate to high-level Turkish in four basic language skills: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Turkish culture.
