YOR 601C Beginning Yoruba 6 Hours

An intensive beginning course with an emphasis on basic skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

YOR 506 First-Year Yoruba I 5 Hours

Standard Yoruba of southwest Nigeria.

YOR 507 First-Year Yoruba II 5 Hours

Continuation of the study of standard Yoruba of southwest Nigeria.

YOR 611C Intermediate Yoruba 6 Hours

An intensive intermediate course with emphasis on basic skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

YOR 312K Second-Year Yoruba I 3 Hours

Oral expression, reading, and comprehension.

YOR 312L Second-Year Yoruba II 3 Hours

Continuation of the study of oral expression, reading, and comprehension.
