The International Business Minor provides undergraduate students at The University of Texas at Austin with a broad knowledge of the workings of the global economy and the opportunity to learn specific functional skills in areas such as finance, accounting, and value chain management that are particularly useful to companies and organizations operating in the international environment. This minor is part of the International Business program in the Business, Government & Society Department of the McCombs School of Business.

Admission to the International Business Minor, is open to undergraduates across The University of Texas at Austin campus, and is based on students' overall academic records. Admission is by application only.
